

# **Installation Materials**

FIXING SURFACE	FIXING MATERIALS
timber fence	screw with large head / staple gun
wire fence	black zip ties
colorbond	metal screws (may require timber frame)
masonry / brick / render / stone / concrete	nylon plug + washer
plasterboard / gyprock	screw with large head + washer

# **Installation Guide**

- **1** If possible, we firstly recommend painting your Wall black for the best finish & to disguise any gaps through your greenery panel (optional).
- **2** Ensure plants on the panels are upwards facing. Over time, the plants will open.
- **3** To begin, start from the top & work left to right.
- **4** Using a spirit level, mark a line at the top of your wall to ensure your panel is straight.
- **5** Secure your first panel in all 4 corners & in the centre.
- 6 Connect the next panel using the hole & lug system on the sides of the grid & secure into place.
- **7** Repeat until finished.
- 8 Using side cutters or scissors, trim any excess grid or plant to finish off your new LUXE Greenery Wall.

## TIMBER FENCE

Hold the panel up to the fence. Use a good quality staple gun (for Greenery panels with plastic backing) or screws with a large head & washer (for Greenery panels with galvanised backing). Secure all 4 corners & in the centre of the panel. Using cutters or scissors, trim excess foliage (if required).

#### **WIRE FENCE**

Hold the panel up to the fence. Using black cable ties push them through the grid & around the fence & pull tight. Use as many cable ties as necessary in all 4 corners & in the centre of the panel. Using cutters or scissors, trim excess cable ties & excess foliage (if required).

### **COLORBOND FENCE**

Screw into metal fencing directly, using metal screws. Please note, you may have screws poke out of the reverse of the fence. We recommend making a timber frame to mount your panels on. Hold the panel up to the frame. Use a good quality staple gun (for Greenery panels with plastic backing) or screws with a large head & washer (for Greenery panels with galvanised backing). Secure all 4 corners & in the centre of the panel. Using cutters or scissors, trim excess foliage (if required).

### MASONRY / BRICK / RENDER / STONE / CONCRETE

Pre-drill hole with a hammer-drill & a masonry drill bit. Hammer in the nylon plug with a large head, making sure you have good coverage of the grid. Add more plugs where necessary to ensure panel is sitting flush on the wall.

## **PLASTERBOARD / GYPROCK**

If possible, screw directly into wall using screws with large thread and head. You may need to use washers as well to ensure you have a good grip on the grid. Secure in all 4 corners & in the centre of the panel to ensure the panel is sitting flush on the wall.



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
